





MIB stands for "Made In Burgundy"

MIB was created in 2019 by Paul Aegerter, a Burgundy wine producer based in Nuits-Saint-Georges, and Martin Sylvestre, a French Certified Sommelier based in NYC.

This company comes from the idea of bringing high quality wines made "A La Bourguignonne" to the North American Continent. "A La Bourguignonne" meaning wines made with passion, focused on Terroir and Climate, and crafted by men in love with their land.

Paul produces wines from the 5 main subregions of Burgundy, starting with regional appellations up to Grands Crus wines.

All wines are crafted by Paul and are defined by his audacious style, made with passion for Burgundy Climate and Terroir and respect of the environment.

With the same vision, MIB provides wines to please every palate, from the adventurer to the collector.



DOMAINE AEGERTER The Terroir for passion

The Domaine Aegerter, located in Nuit-Saint-Georges, Côte-d'Or, is thriving in a region known for both its traditions and its innovations.

Great lover of Burgundy, Jean-Luc Aegerter took over a small trading house in Nuits-Saint-Georges in 1988, with the ambition of participating in the revelation of the great terroirs of Burgundy. In 1994, the Domaine acquired its first plot of land: Nuits-Saint-Georges Les Plateaux; which he completed with other plots such as Savigny-lès-Beaune, Chorey-lès-Beaune.

Very soon his son, Paul, joined him in the adventure. He travelled the terroirs, tried his hand at new vinification methods and met wine lovers from all over the world. A tireless worker, creative and innovative, he imagines terroir wines but also wines for sharing, aimed at both novices and the most demanding wine lovers.

Together, they dusted off Burgundy, went off the beaten track and brought a resolutely modern vision to their wines. A single line of conduct: enhancing the value of the terroirs, respecting each berry, reflecting each climate.

Today, the Domaine owns 10 hectares and, thanks to the fermentations and grape contracts, vinifies more than 50 hectares and covers 42 appellations in the heart of Burgundy, from Chablisien to Mâconnais; from the regional appellation to the Grand Cru. Paul Aegerter is present at every stage, from the management of the vineyard to the harvest and vinification.

The story continues with his wife, Sophie. At his side, she transmits the values of the Domaine and accompanies him in the elaboration of each project.

Passionate lovers of Burgundy, Sophie & Paul are enthusiastic about the rebirth of the Dijon vineyard, which had practically disappeared, and are replanting no less than 2 hectares of chardonnay in 2019 in the climate of the Motte Giron.

They will also be present at the birth of the Vézelay appellation with a cuvée from the first vintage that will be unanimously acclaimed by many tasters.

This will be followed by Burgundy rosé, with the launch of MIB - Made In Burgundy.



In 2019, Paul acquired a Burgundy historical domaine: «Clavelier», owned by his mother Isabelle Thomas. This «Maison Bourguignonne» was founded in 1935 by Antoine Clavelier. It added 3 hectares of vines to Aegerter domaine and 20+new appellations.

All the wines produced by Clavelier remain under the same name, it brings a perfect complementarity to Aegerter Winery - classic Burgundy wines made with the same passion for terroir and climate. beginners and experts alike, carefully picked selections, new blends and different bottles

Always in search of something new, Domaine Aegerter took over Maison Hérout, an organic cider house, pioneer of the Cotentin AOC, located in Auvers (Manche) in 2018. Accompanied by 3 friends, Paul Aegerter continues the history of this cider house of excellence.

Far from the fashions, they rethink the wines with, in the depths of each decision, the desire to highlight the formidable expressions of Burgundy.

With no family history, their only weapons being their passion, their determination, their audacity and the ambition to create great wines, Jean-Luc and Paul have built an estate rooted in the mythical lands of Burgundy and radiating to the four corners of the world. Passers of emotions, they have brought their wines on the bridge between modernity and tradition, between fruit and terroirs.




